

## **NEWS ABOUT YOUR VOTER REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE**

### **From the Brewster County Elections Office**

As you are aware- the yellow Voter Registration Certificates expired in December 2025.

The Texas Secretary of State is experiencing delays in processing and pushing data to counties- until we receive this information- we cannot print new certificates. This is a statewide issue and not restricted to Brewster County. As soon as we receive the necessary information in our elections office- new certificates will be printed and mailed out.

*Please know that this does not impact your ability to vote-if you were a qualified registered voter last year- you still are- that registration does not expire. You do not need your certificate to vote on election day- just bring a valid photo ID with you.*

Remember, Early Voting for the Primary Election runs February 17 through February 27 at the Val Clark Beard Office Complex in Alpine. Election Day is March 3, and you must vote in your precinct that day.
